## Practice Page 15A

#### – -al —

In single-syllable words, the ending *-al* has a short-*a* sound and says /ăl/. In multisyllabic words, the ending *-al* has a schwa sound and says /əl/.

#### Example: final

A **schwa** /a/ is a vowel sound similar to the short-*u* sound in *up*. It is found only in unaccented syllables of multisyllabic words.

In single-syllable words, the ending *-ic* has a short-*i* sound and says /ĭk/. In multisyllabic words, the ending *-ic* also has a short-*i* sound and says /ĭk/.
