Integrate oral and written English language instruction into content-area teaching.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read Aloud Cards</li> <li>• Lesson Guide</li> </ul>	<p>The routines in the Language Comprehension &amp; Vocabulary section of the Lesson Guide are especially beneficial for multilingual learners.</p> <p>When presenting content on the Read Aloud Cards, have students repeat the words after you say them to reinforce vocabulary acquisition.</p> <p>Highlight the written information on the cards to help students make the connection between the printed and spoken word, which helps expand vocabulary and builds automaticity.</p> <p>Pair students with varied language proficiency for peer-learning opportunities to discuss the text and practice using new vocabulary.</p>
Provide small-group instructional intervention.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Decodable Readers</li> <li>• Lesson Guide</li> </ul>	Work through the Phonics/Word Fluency and Fluency/Comprehension routines, which will help multilingual students develop and strengthen their foundational reading skills and build comprehension.
Teach phonics in context.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Decodable Readers</li> <li>• Lesson Guide</li> </ul>	Use the routines in the Phonics & Word Fluency section of the Lesson Guide to provide systematic phonics instruction with the Decodable Readers.
Check comprehension frequently.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Decodable Readers</li> <li>• Read Aloud Cards</li> <li>• Lesson Guide</li> </ul>	<p>Ask comprehension questions to multilingual students that require them to reflect on what they have heard or read. Be sure to include main idea, literal recall, and text-connection questions to gauge if students have understood texts in a deep and meaningful way.</p> <p>Evaluate their level of understanding and provide support to remediate as needed.</p>
